Project Overview

Each student will:

- Create a **tri-fold poster board display**
- Be prepared to **talk about their project and answer general questions**

Choosing a Topic

Students should pick something they truly enjoy or want to learn more about!

Examples:

- Animals or habitats
- A favorite sport or athlete
- Space or planets
- A historical figure
- Art techniques
- A cultural tradition
- How something works

Tri-Fold Poster Board & Props

Students will create a **tri-fold display board** that should include:

- Project Title
- Student's Name and Age
- Key facts or findings
- Supporting details
- Pictures (printed or drawn)
- Diagrams, charts, or illustrations (if applicable)

Bring Props! (Optional but Encouraged)

Students are welcome to bring props, models, or objects that help demonstrate their project. These items can make the display more interactive and help others better understand the topic.

Each student will have table space to display their tri-fold poster board along with any additional items they would like to showcase.
